WHO CAN PARTICIPATE:

Residents within the city limits of Milford for items not normally collected and have purchased clean- up tags from the Milford City Clerk's office. No waste from non-residential customers, contractors, businesses or those residing outside the City limits will be accepted.

WHERE TO PURCHASE:

Milford City Clerk's office at 806 N Avenue, office hours are Monday-Friday 7:30-4:00.

All items should be boxed, bagged or contained in some manner and under 40 pounds or they will not be accepted. Absolutely NO loads of loose shingles or tires will be accepted!

WHEN TO PURCHASE CLEAN-UP TAGS:

Residents can purchase clean-up tags starting Monday, June 16th, 2025 through Friday, June 20th, 2025 - NO EXCEPTIONS

WHEN TO PLACE ITEMS BY CURB (once the collection truck has been by it will not return):

Saturday, June 21st, 2025 - For residents who purchased a clean-up tag.

Items must be placed curbside by 6:00 AM

(Okoboji Ave. residences with alley need to place items in alley)

UNACCEPTABLE ITEMS THAT WILL NOT BE COLLECTED:

- Radioactive Materials Naturally Occurring (NORM)
- Hazardous, Industrial and Infectious Waste

THE FOLLOWING ITEMS WILL NOT BE COLLECTED BUT ARE ACCEPTED AT DICKINSON COUNTY REGIONAL COLLECTION CENTER (712-338-2549):

- Batteries (Includes: auto, flashlight, rechargeable, etc.)
 - Oils, Oil Rags (Includes: any type of oil drilling waste)
 - Chemical Products (Includes: herbicides, pesticides)
 - Tires
 - Fluorescent Tubes and Light Bulbs
 - Yard Waste (Includes: grass clippings, tree and shrub) waste)
 - Liquid Waste, Paints, Thinners, Removers
